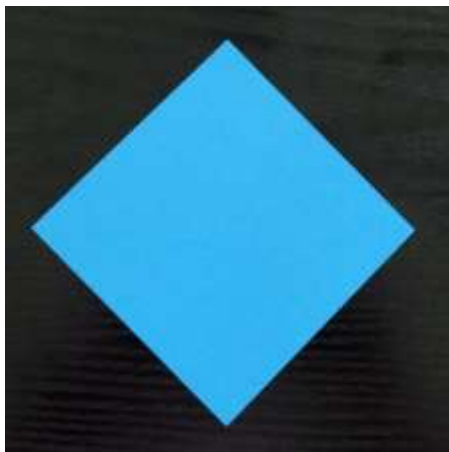
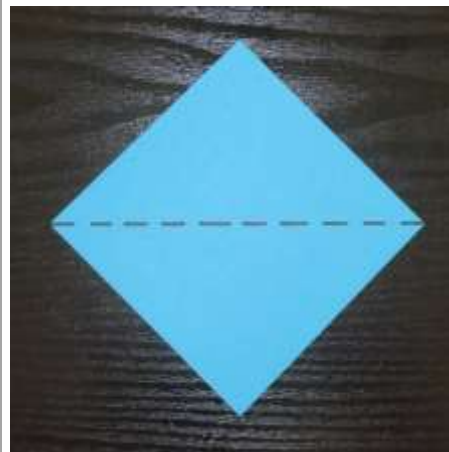


16-point Star 1

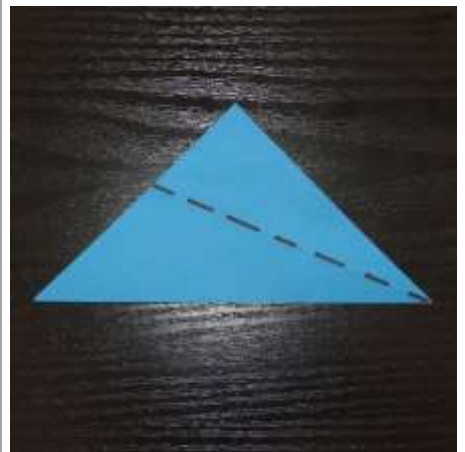
The units are very like those for the Simple Star – only the yellow photographs are different



Take a square of paper



Fold it upwards



Fold the top layer down
(but not the back layer)



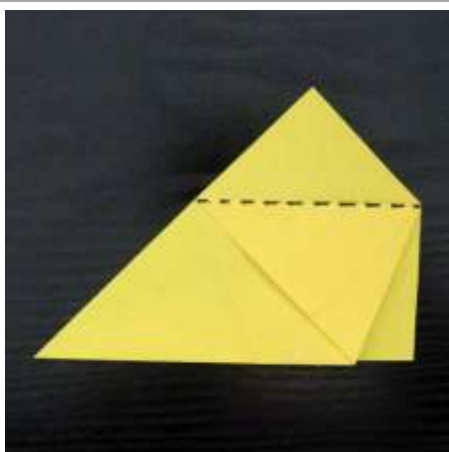
Fold the bottom corner over to
meet the end of the last fold - but
just crease the top end



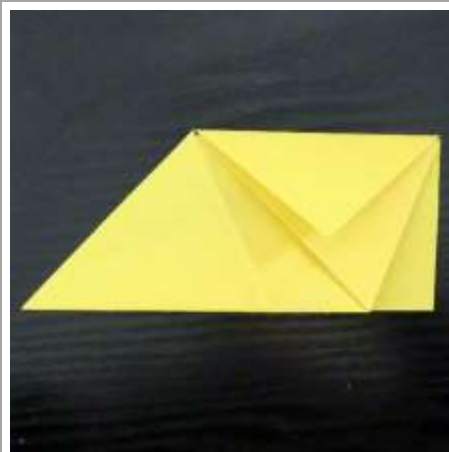
This is how it looks.



Then turn the whole thing over
and fold to the top end of the
crease you just made



For the 16-point star, fold the
entire top flap down



Open the top up again, and open
the triangular flap in the middle.

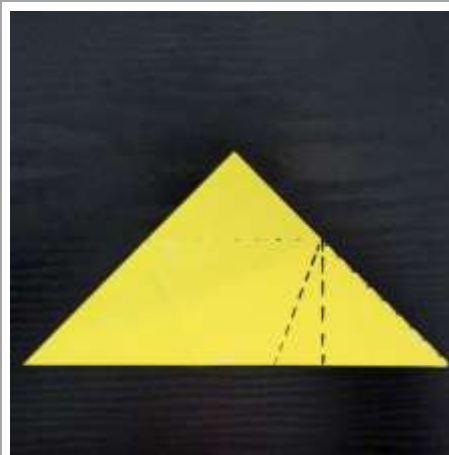


Fold the right-hand flap again, but
this time fold it to lie along the
bottom edge. There's a crease
line just where the point goes

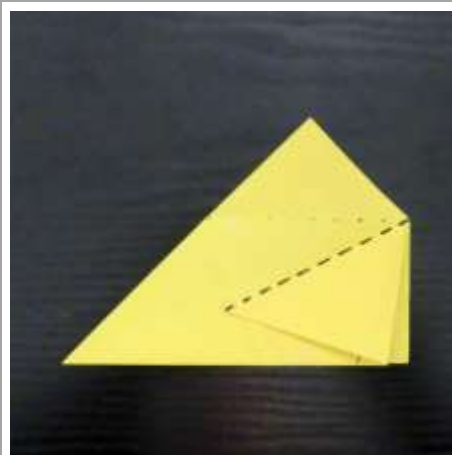
16-point Star 2



Open the flap up again



There are now two creases for the right-hand flap. Fold the flap so that one crease ends up on top of the other



And it's done. Notice how the two creases lie on top of each other, leaving a small flap on the right



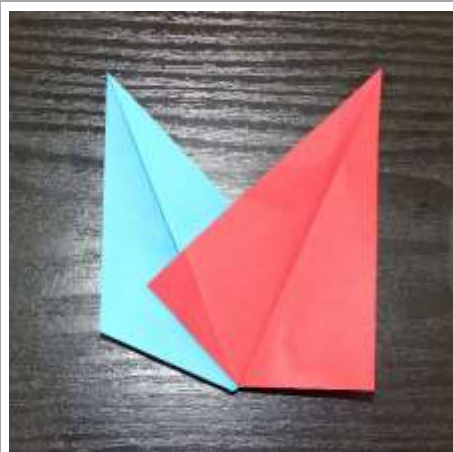
Make 16 units



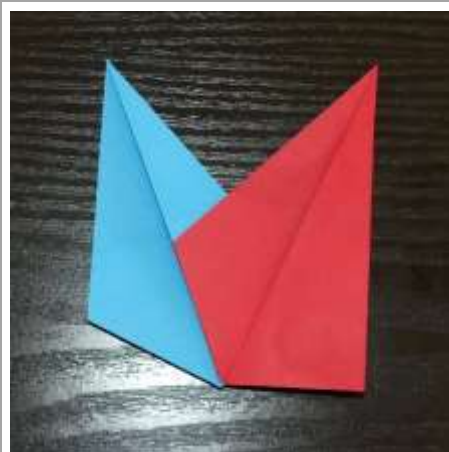
Slot 2 together; push all the layers of the blue unit into the flap of the red one



Push them neatly together



Turn it over... and fold the little flap in to lock the units together



Flap folded in
Connect all 16 units
